Exam Format

Cambridge English: Advanced consists of 5 papers. Each of the five papers contributes 20% of the total marks available.

Paper	Content	Marks (% of total)	Purpose
Reading (1hr 15 min)	4 Sections/34 questions	20%	Requires candidates to show they can understand and deal confidently with different types of English language text
Writing (1hr 30 min)	2 Tasks Task 1 - Compulsory Task 2 - Choice based (5 choices)	20%	Candidates must show they can write non-specialised types of English language text, such as an article, an essay, a letter, a proposal or a report
30 minute break			
Use of English (1hr)	5 Parts/50 questions	20%	Requires candidates to demonstrate their ability to apply their knowledge of English vocabulary and grammatical structures appropriate to the C1 level
Listening (40 min)	4 Sections/30 questions (Recording played twice)	20%	Requires candidates to be able to follow and understand a range of spoken materials such as lectures, speeches, interviews, discussions and anecdotes
Speaking (15 min)	Paired format (2 candidates/2 examiners)	20%	Offers candidates the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to use spoken language skills effectively in a range of contexts
